

Romans 8:18 For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us. (NKJV)



Prayer for Renewal and Revival

As we continue to join our hearts in prayer for Renewal and Revival, my prayer is for the Lord to give us the joy of knowing our Savior. Specifically, that we would not just go through the motions of celebrating the birth of Christ and a new year, but that we would rejoice in the wonder and majesty of it all just like those who were the first to experience it.

Perhaps the Christmas Season has become somewhat of a routine for you. Familiar decorations, songs, and outfits have become comfortable, lackluster, and faded. The wonder of the birth of Christ is overplayed in your mind, just like "All I Want For Christmas Is You". Or perhaps it is worse than that. You have become so familiar with Christmas, that it no longer brings joy, or it is only a time of year for you to go into deeper debt. For you Christmas is a rut. Vance Havner once said, "Many people are in a rut and a rut is nothing but a grave - with both ends kicked out." For the next two months I would encourage you to look at Luke 2:1-38 to guide your prayer time.

As you study this passage notice the joy and excitement surrounding the birth of Christ. Think about all the different groups and individuals who knew even from His first days that Jesus was and is the Messiah. Put yourself in the sandals of the lowly shepherds. Under normal circumstances, they would likely have been some of the last to hear of the birth of a king. They not only got to see him early, they switched from shepherds to shouters as they made sure everyone in town knew about the birth of Christ. Think about how their life was changed.

Simeon and Anna also rejoiced in the presence of the infant Savior. They did not know the path that the life of Christ would take, but they knew His destination. Imagine the wonder of Joseph and Mary as the two strangers acknowledged the baby in their arms was the Savior of not just Israel, but the world as well. Two Thousand years later, it is easy read right over the excitement that surrounded the birth of the Christ. Chose this year to tune out the hustle and bustle of the world to listen to joyful sounds of the witnesses of the Messiah's birth.

As you finish, please continue in prayer for the following items:

- 1. Ask the Lord to help you see wonder of the birth of Christ.
- 2. Ask the Lord to help you see why His birth was necessary.
- 3. Thank the Lord that Jesus was willing to leave the splendor of heaven in order to be the Savior of
- 4. all mankind and for all eternity.
- 5. Pray that people would find out about Him and follow Him this Christmas and New Year Season.
- 6. Pray that your message to others would be the same no matter who they are, or how you are
- 7. received.
- 8. Pray for missionaries and church leaders around the world. That God gives them favor and insight with those they are called to.
- 9. Pray for the needs of the others on your team, yourself, and church (including your pastor and staff).
- 10. Pray that the Lord would make this a sweet time that you would look forward to each month.
- 11. Pray that God would send more people to pray.
- 12. Pray that the Lord would extend the free gift of salvation to those in your community and family.
- 13. Pray that God would raise up people in your church that will be intentional disciples of Christ.
- 14. Pray that no matter the circumstances, you will follow Jesus, and other believers will too.
- 15. Pray that the Lord will help you see that nothing is more valuable than your relationship with Him.
