We live down a road without streetlights. There are lots of trees that border the road. There are deer and other animals that like to run across the road. This can make driving at night hazardous. So, a few years back, I added something to my truck that I thought would help. It is called a bull bar, and it protects the center of my front bumper. If you look at it just right, it makes my truck look like it has an underbite. But that is not all. In the bar, there is an LED light bar. When I turn it on, it is brighter by itself than my high-beam headlights. It makes the dark road we live on, much easier to navigate, in the dark, or in the fog. In fact, when it is on, I can see wider and further than I can without it.

Our vision of the future is often dark and dim. Similar to the road we live on at night. We think we know what the road ahead holds, but often we cannot see the hazards before us. I do not run those lights when the sun is out. I have no need, for even when I turn all my lights on high, I cannot tell a difference when the sun is out. When I read Proverbs 3:5-6, it reminds me that my understanding is nothing compared to the Lord's. His knowledge of the road ahead and any proverbial bumps or animals on it is infinitely greater than our own. When we have fully put our trust in Him, we have found this to be true.

I so often attempt to lean on my own understanding. I know full well this is a bad choice, yet I make it anyway. When I do that, I am no longer acknowledging the Lord. When I do that, I should not be surprised to discover He is no longer directing my path. I encourage you today, ask the Lord this question, "Am I fully trusting in you?" If not, I find it highly unlikely you are acknowledging Him in all your ways. Return your trust in Him today, so that His directions will be clear when the path is light, and when it is dark.



Prayer for Renewal and Revival

Recently, there have been a number of protests at the home of some Supreme Court Justices. It appears this is because of a leaked draft of an opinion that if it became the judgment of the court, would send abortion decisions back to the states. At that point, state legislators would have to pass laws to codify when and if abortion would be legal. The desire of these protestors seems to be to change the mind of the court on this case so that Roe would remain the law of the land. It is quite possible by the time you read this the court will have made a decision on the case that we pray will overturn Roe. It is also possible that the court may bow to the pressure that these protestors and lawmakers have placed on them, and allow Roe to stand.

God will not bless what He has already condemned. In other words, God doesn't change His mind. He doesn't change His mind because we don't like what He has said. He will never hear our objections and think better of His previous decisions. We cannot badger Him, plead with Him, or wear Him down. He is the same yesterday, today, and forever. I, for one, am glad that He does not change His mind. Think about it, if God was given to changing His mind on subjects we do not like, what is to stop Him from changing His mind on subjects we do like?

God has given clear instruction on how to place your faith in the work of Jesus in order that we may receive the gift of eternal life. What if God changed His mind? What if there were someone else we need to place our faith in now? If God changed His mind on anything, then everything would be in flux, including, and perhaps most importantly, salvation. With that in mind, this month, I encourage you to study Daniel chapter 3. It is quite possible this passage will be very familiar to you. Yet, I would ask that you read it with this in mind: Why did the Hebrew young men refuse? What was their response when the king gave them one last chance? What was the end result of their faithfulness? Notice that the young men did not protest, or parade their objections. They simply told the king, we must serve the Lord above all.

Allow the following to guide you as you pray:

- 1. Ask the Lord to help you stand firm against the tide that would seek to negate His Word.
- 2. Ask the Lord to show you any beliefs, convictions, or traditions that you have that do not obey His Word.
- 3. Thank God that He never changes. Thank Him because of His steadfastness your salvation is secure.
- 4. Ask the Lord for opportunities to speak the truth in love, and to have opportunities to live the truth so that others may know Him.
- 5. Ask that God would give you opportunities to serve others.
- 6. Ask the Lord to send revival and renewal to your life and the church you serve.
- 7. Pray that the Lord would help you show the love of Christ to others, especially those in the church.
- 8. Pray for the needs of the others on your team, yourself, and church (including your pastor and staff).
- 9. Pray that God would send more people to pray.
- 10. Pray that the Lord would extend the free gift of salvation to those in your community and family.
- 11. Pray that God would raise up church leaders and missionaries to labor in His fields.
- 12. Pray that the gospel would advance regardless of what is happening locally or globally.
