

John 1:14 "And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth." (NKJV)

'Tis the Season! The season that we celebrate the birth of our Savior, Jesus Christ. In the Old Testament, God often made sure that people knew He was nearby. 

Prayer for Renewal and Revival

Who was your favorite teacher growing up? Or perhaps a better question is, what kind of teacher did you respond positively to? What type of teacher aided your learning? Made you a better student? Was it the kind that put stickers on your paper, or who wrote encouraging notes? Or was it the teacher who made sure that you comprehended what was being taught? Maybe it was the teacher who took interest in you outside the classroom in a club, a sport, or an activity?

The best teachers to me were relatable. When I saw them outside of class, they knew my name. When I ran into them after being out of their class for years, they asked me how I was doing. It wasn't so much the subject as it was the teacher. In fact, in one case, I had a great teacher early enough in my education that I was able to endure average teachers in the same class because she had instilled in me a love for the subject.

Prior to the incarnation, God spent centuries showing favor to the world and specifically to the Israelites. John recaps this in the first chapter of his Gospel. Take a moment now to read John 1:1-17. As you do, notice the language that John uses to describe the Word (Jesus). Notice how John lifts Jesus up above Moses the great lawgiver of the Israelites. Not by tearing down Moses, but by showing Jesus is the one who gave Moses the truth he proclaimed. While John the Baptist was the immediate forerunner to Christ, Moses was the one who sowed the seeds of belief within the Hebrew people.

Jesus was/is more than a good teacher. In fact, He was the best teacher, ever. He is also the subject matter. Like sitting at the feet of Thomas Edison to learn about how he came up with a light bulb. Traveling back in time to learn from our Nation's Founding Fathers. Jesus' presence is not just "like" talking to God, it is talking to God, learning from the Master.

As we think about Christmas and the New Year which are just ahead, allow this thought to encourage and revive you, that God, the Son, left His throne in heaven in order to walk on earth. He came to teach us, not from afar, but close up. He let His followers see Him at all times of the day and night. He knew we could not pass the ultimate test on our own, so He allowed us to sign our name to His perfect paper at great sacrifice. What greater message could we have this Christmas than the one that John proclaims? That a Savoir has entered the world in order to allow us to be made right with God, through His righteousness.

As you pray allow the following to guide you:

- 1. Thank the Lord for the birth of Christ.
- 2. Thank the Lord for His perfect life, sacrificial death, and redemptive resurrection.
- 3. Ask the Lord that He helps you not get caught up in the glitter and extras of the season, but see Jesus.
- 4. Ask the Lord to help you share about life in Christ with others in your family and daily life.
- 5. Ask the Lord to send revival and renewal (living water) to your life and the church you serve.
- 6. Pray that the Lord would help you show the love of Christ to others, especially those far from God.
- 7. Pray for the needs of the others on your team, yourself, and your church (including your pastor and staff).
- 8. Pray that God would send more people to pray.
- 9. Pray that the Lord would extend the free gift of salvation to those in your community and family.
- 10. Pray that God would raise up church leaders and missionaries to labor in His fields.
- 11. Pray that the gospel would advance regardless of what is happening locally or globally.
