DOM Thoughts

Habakkuk 3:2 "O LORD, I have heard Your speech and was afraid; O LORD, revive Your work in the midst of the years! In the midst of the years make it known; In wrath remember mercy" NKJV

I remember exactly where I was when 9/11 happened. I remember exactly where I was when I first saw video of the Challenger Explosion. I remember where I was when I heard that the Berlin wall had begun to be destroyed. Sometimes, events are so momentous that when you found out that they happened, it becomes unforgettable. It impacts you in a way that is difficult to describe. I have heard that is how it was for the Asbury College Revival of 1970. I pray that is how it is for what has gone on in recent days at that same place.

In 1970 what started at Asbury College spread to other Universities and churches. Henry C. James tells us, "Before long, appeals began coming from other campuses for Asbury students to come and tell the story.... By the summer of 1970 at least 130 colleges, seminaries and Bible Schools had been touched by the revival outreach." Will what started on February 8th be the beginning of another wave of revival that sweeps our land? Time will tell.

What we know for sure is that God is still at work in His people. Moreover, like Habakkuk we can cry out to the Lord for Revival. Unlike those in the day of the prophet, believers today each have the Holy Spirit in our lives sanctifying us from within. We can pray that if what began at Asbury University a few weeks ago is pleasing to the Lord, that it spreads throughout our nation and world. The world needs to know the Jesus of the Bible. Many of those who know Him, desperately need revival.

In 2017, there was another event that sticks in my mind. How Southwest Georgia responded to the impact of two weather events in January of that year. In the recovery effort of those storms, I began to pray specifically for revival and renewal in Southwest Georgia. As an association, we began to pray for it. We invited churches and individuals to join us in prayer. In June of 2021, we challenged churches to take one day a month, and bathe it in prayer for revival. We even began a monthly guided devotion to that end. You will find it in the Messenger each month.

The result of the revival fires in the SBC is that in 1971-1975 we saw more baptisms than at any other point in our convention. Our seminaries had more new students than ever before. I pray that the fire that started on February 8th finds hearts ready for revival all over our nation, but especially in SW GA.


Our Uttermost Parts of the World

Prayer for Renewal and Revival

Revival embers once thought doused, have ignited once again. Amazingly one of the places where it seems to be growing is among a generation that far too many have written off, Gen Z. What is interesting to me is that many wrote off the late Boomers of the 1960s. Many of them turned away from the church, and her traditions and teachings. What they saw in churches while the nation struggled with Civil Rights, and fought in Vietnam, did not line up with what they read in Scripture. Many of them were tempted away from the truth of God, to a life that emphasized carnality and hedonism. Many of these same young people returned to the Lord in the early 1970s. It was a point of revival within our nation, and it was ignited by the Holy Spirit in the lives of the teens and young adults. One of the flash points for this revival was at a small independent Christian College in the middle of Kentucky, Asbury College.

There are some who call what has happened there a “Revival”. Others have flatly denounced it as a move of the flesh, not the Spirit. Which is it? I have hope that it is genuine. What I know is that God does not need our permission to act. There were certainly those in Jesus’ day that did not believe that He was sent by God. They even said He had a demon at least once. Only time will tell if recent events at what is now Asbury University were the beginnings of a revival. There is something we can do right now. We can pray. We are not certain exactly where all this is going or where it will lead, but we can trust God who is already there. Something similar happened in Acts 1:7-15. Please stop here and read this passage in your Bible.

To say that this day didn’t go as the disciples thought would be an understatement. They were expecting Jesus to take over the government, not take flight into the clouds. They were expecting to kick out the Roman occupiers in Jerusalem, not be witnesses in Jerusalem, Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth. They expected to serve with Jesus, not without Him. Perplexed they head back to the upper room and wait... in prayer. They didn’t exactly know what was going to happen except that they would receive power when the Holy Spirit arrived. What happened next was a movement of God. It was His movement, in His way, in His time. So, I ask that today you pray for exactly that, God’s movement, in His way, in His time. Pray that God would show you what personal revival looks like. Don’t quench the Holy Spirit. If He is moving, don’t end this time because your hour is up. Let Him end this time in your life.

As you pray allow the following to guide you:

1. Thank the Lord for the renewed interest in the teachings of Christ.
2. Pray that what is happening in several colleges and universities is a true act of the Lord, and that it spreads throughout our nation and world.
3. Thank the Lord for His perfect life, sacrificial death, and redemptive resurrection.
4. Ask the Lord to help you obey Him so that you might show Him and others that you love Him.
5. Ask the Lord to help you share about life in Christ with others in your family and daily life.
6. Ask the Lord to send revival and renewal (living water) to your life and the church you serve.
7. Pray that the Lord would help you show the love of Christ to others, especially those far from God.
8. Pray for the needs of the others on your team, yourself, and your church (including your pastor and staff).
9. Pray that God would send more people to pray.
10. Pray that the Lord would extend the free gift of salvation to those in your community and family.
11. Pray that God would raise up church leaders and missionaries to labor in His fields.
12. Pray that the gospel would advance regardless of what is happening locally or globally.
13. Pray that the Lord would show you ways that your personal obedience to Him can increase.
