



### **DOM Thoughts**

Jeremiah 17:9 "The heart is deceitful above all things, And desperately wicked; Who can know it?" NKJV "Follow your heart." This is a phrase popular culture uses with great regularity. Watch a TV show or a movie where someone has to make a decision between pursuing a relationship with one person or another. Quite often someone will tell that character, "Follow your heart." The problem is that sometimes my heart is good at giving direction, and sometimes it is horrible at giving direction. It is almost as if I have two different hearts, one that leads me astray, and one that leads me to righteousness.

What is the difference between a deceitful heart and a righteous heart? When the Bible speaks of the heart, sometimes, it does so in very positive terms. In those cases, following your heart would lead someone in the appropriate direction. The Bible also speaks of the heart in negative terms, such as Jeremiah here in this verse. Following this heart would result in terrible consequences. So, how do we know which heart to follow? How can we trust that our heart is leading us in the right direction?

A couple of verses above this one in Jeremiah's book, we see a comparison between the man who trusts in himself (v. 5) and the man who trusts in the Lord (v.7). That is the key. What is informing your heart? If your heart is being informed by man (yourself, or others), anxiety, lust, or emotion, in general, there is a strong possibility your heart will lead you the wrong way. However, if your heart is informed by Scripture, the Bible calls that a wise heart. This heart will lead you the way that follows the Lord.

The trouble is, even wise hearts have moments of weakness. But, there is a way to check behind your heart to know if it is being wise and righteous or deceitful and foolish. A wise heart will never lead you to do something that the Bible tells you is wrong. It will never tell you to lie, cheat on your spouse, or do anything else that the Bible warns us against. So, the next time you want to follow your heart, do yourself a favor, check behind it with Scripture.







#### Prayer for Renewal and Revival

Throughout the Bible, wisdom is held up as something we should desire to have. This is the foundation of the book of Proverbs, but it shows up in many of the different books in the Bible. Did you know that not all "wisdom" is created equal? Wisdom can basically come from two places, the world or the Lord. But one type is better than the other. Wisdom from the Lord will always lead you down the best path. Wisdom from the world will, at times, lead you astray. Wisdom guides how we speak, the tone we use, the words we use, and more. Wisdom helps us take the knowledge that we have gained and put it into practice appropriately.

The wisdom that comes from the Lord, not only comes out in words but in actions as well. James speaks to this well. Please stop and read James 3:13-18. As you do, note how James describes the two types of wisdom. Please also pay attention to how James contrasts the two and how they are applied.

Revival in our lives includes introspection. It helps to ask if the wisdom we are employing has characteristics of wisdom from the Lord or the world. Sometimes this is not easy. Mainly because we have to come to grips with the fact that we may not be the most normal person we know. Not everyone thinks like we do. As you pray through these characteristics of wisdom that come from the world, ask the Lord to show you which you could stand to work on. As you pray through the wisdom that comes from the Lord, thank Him for giving you this wisdom to guide your life and bless others.

As you pray allow the following to guide you:

- 1. Thank the Lord for the wisdom He freely gives to all believers (James 1:5).
- 2. Ask the Lord to show you how you can use the wisdom that comes from Him for His glory and honor.
- 3. Thank the Lord for His perfect life, sacrificial death, and redemptive resurrection.
- 4. Ask the Lord to help you obey Him so that you might show Him and others that you love Him.
- 5. Ask the Lord to help you share about life in Christ with others in your family and daily life.
- 6. Ask the Lord to send revival and renewal (living water) to your life and the church you serve.
- 7. Pray that the Lord would help you show the love of Christ to others, especially those far from God.
- 8. Pray for the needs of the others on your team, yourself, and your church (including your pastor and staff).
- 9. Pray that God would send more people to pray.
- 10. Pray that the Lord would extend the free gift of salvation to those in your community and family.
- 11. Pray that God would raise up church leaders and missionaries to labor in His fields.
- 12. Pray that the gospel would advance regardless of what is happening locally or globally.
- 13. Pray that the Lord would show you ways that your personal obedience to Him can increase.
