And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one." (Luke 11:4 NKJV)

When we become aware of our sin, forgiveness is something we want to receive, but may not be something we want to give. We don't always want to forgive, and that might mean we do not know how to forgive. Many of us have heard the phrase, "forgive and forget". But as it relates to us, I haven't found that in the Bible. God can forgive and forget, and that, in and of itself, is amazing. Think about it, the God who knows everything chooses to forget something. And some well-meaning soul said, if that is the way God does it, it should be the way we do it, and normally, that is a good rule of thumb. We should strive to be more like Jesus and obey Him moment by moment. This verse from Luke's account of what is known as the *Lord's Prayer*, says, we should forgive because we are forgiven.

The issue, then, is not if we should forgive, but that we should forgive within our capacity. God can choose to forget and He does. Now, while I do not possess an eidetic memory (photographic), try as I may, there are things I would love to forget, but I cannot. I cannot forget them unless I have some sort of trauma or illness. Now, if that is the way God made us, then we lack the capacity to forget. And because of the phrase, "forgive and forget," I beat myself up for not being able to do something that I lack the capacity to do.

So then how do we forgive? May I suggest we learn from the event, and do all within our power not to repeat it. Furthermore, we no longer hold the event over the other person's head, essentially saying, "If you do anything like this again, I am going to remind you of this," which arguably is still not easy. It is within our capacity. An example of this is, when someone hurts someone, you love. You can forgive that person (even if they do not apologize or repent), and no longer hold that event over them. However, that does not require you to allow your loved one to go back into a situation where it could happen again.

This leads us to the last part of this verse. God loves you, and while the temptation may be all around you to return to the sin for which you just asked forgiveness for, God has a better plan. He desires to lead you away from the temptation and deliver you from the evil one. But, if you do yield to that temptation, isn't it good to know God is willing to start this process all over with you, and that is all because of Jesus, without whom, none of this would be possible.
