DOM Thoughts

Acts 11:26b ... And the disciples were first called Christians in Antioch.

Here lately, I have been getting several people who say, "You remind me of someone." Within the last few months, I have been told I look like David Letterman, Andrew Peterson, and David Harbour (I had to look this last one up, too). It seems the older I get, the more I look like other people. Honestly, only one of those people would I be pleased with being confused for. This wasn't the first time. In June of 2005, the SBC annual meeting was held in Nashville, TN. A younger leader named Ed Stetzer was becoming very popular. Dr. Stetzer was good at doing research and writing books, and at the time, I could pass for him. We were about the same build, although, I am taller. We have a similar hair color, and at the time, we both had a goatee. During that entire convention, people would come up to me in the exhibit hall, and thank me for what I had to say from the platform earlier in the meeting. I told the first few guys that I wasn't him, but after a while, it was easier just to say, "Thank you." While that makes for a good story, there is someone else I would much rather look like, Jesus.

In Acts 11, we find Paul and Barnabas in the church at Antioch. They spoke of Jesus so often that you could not speak of either one, without mentioning the name of Jesus. For a whole year, the church at Antioch had the privilege of hearing them teach about Jesus. What was the result of a year-long Bible study with Paul and Barnabas? The disciples at Antioch, not just Paul and Barnabas, but all the disciples at Antioch, were called Christians, literally, "little Christs." Why? Because they acted like Christ.

Friends that should be the goal of discipleship in our churches today; to educate with the desire to see life change. It is not simply the desire to have knowledgeable Christians, but to have Christians that look like, have the mind, heart, and Spirit of our Savior, Jesus Christ. The goal is that we should lose our identity in the world and find it in Christ. Knowing where to find Chronicles and Corinthians in the Bible is great. Knowing which one is in the Old Testament and which is in the New is good too. Neither one of those is great unless it impacts how we act, and who we are because we KNOW Jesus. Just like Paul and Barnabas, I hope that when people speak of me, they will have to talk about Jesus too.




